Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are pleased that you and your student continue to be a part of the Xavier College Preparatory High School community, and we hope that your experience here is one your family will treasure for a lifetime. All of us at Xavier are committed to providing a setting that enables young people to develop strong academic skills and moral principles. These ideals were set forth by St. Ignatius of Loyola nearly five centuries ago.

While a Xavier education remains one of the best values among college-preparatory high schools in the valley, the actual cost of educating each student at Xavier is \$21,100. The subsidized tuition for every student for the coming year is set at \$17,250. In essence, every family – including yours – receives a subsidy of \$3,750. We intentionally do this to help make a Xavier education more affordable for our families.

As you reflect on your family's financial situation, we ask you to seriously consider the following question, **“Does our family need the subsidy in order to enroll and keep your student at Xavier or can we cover the true cost of tuition?”**

We hope that you will consider paying \$21,100, of which \$3,750 is tax-deductible or give a gift above tuition, if possible. The expectation is that every family will help according to their ability. Giving a donation above tuition would be a tremendous gift to our community and will assist in our mission of educating women and men with and for others.

To reserve a place for your student for the 2024-2025 school year, you must complete the tuition form online and provide a \$500 deposit.
