### OUR MISSION

Xavier College Preparatory, a Roman Catholic, Jesuit high school, actively seeks, educates, and nurtures young men and women from a wide variety of ethnic, socioeconomic, and religious backgrounds in the Coachella Valley. Supporting the role of parents as primary educators, Xavier is dedicated to developing conscientious leaders, agents of change who are open to growth, intellectually competent, religious, loving, committed to justice, and compassionate in their service to others for the greater glory of God.

### OUR STORY

Since 1999 a group of parents worked hard to build the first Catholic high school in the Coachella Valley. Xavier College Preparatory opened its doors to 48 freshmen in 2006. The student body reflects the socioeconomic and ethnic diversity of the Valley, and includes a vibrant community of international students. Xavier seeks to educate the whole person, and is rooted in the Jesuit tradition of forming men and women with and for others.

### HONOR SOCIETY ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (NHS, NAHS)

National Honor Society: Open to students in grades 11-12 with a minimum unweighted cumulative GPA of 3.8.  
National Art Honor Society: Open to students with an un-weighted GPA of 4.0 in two or more visual arts classes.

### HONORS AND ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES

All course offerings are College Prep (CP) level courses unless designated Honors (H) or Advanced Placement (AP). AP courses are not allowed freshman year. One AP class is allowed Sophomore year; up to three are offered Junior year; up to four for senior year. All students who take an AP course at Xavier are required to take the AP exam for that course. Honors and AP courses each have course and minimum letter grade prerequisites. In general, to be eligible for a course at the next level of rigor, a student must have a grade of 'A-' or higher in the prerequisite course(s) or maintain a grade of 'B' in the prerequisite course(s) in order to stay at the same level or rigor (H/AP); teacher approval was required up through and including 2021-2022. Pre-AP courses were launched in 2022-2023.

### COVID STATEMENT

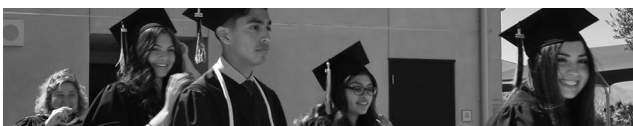
Xavier College Prep entered fully remote learning in March 2020. Hybrid learning in cohorts began in October 2020, with a return to full in-person instruction in March 2021.

### BASICS

Our new academic school year starts August 8, 2022 and runs until the last day of school, May 19, 2023. Classes begin at 8 am and end at 2:40 pm. Friday's classes end at 12:55 pm. Xavier maintains a GPA letter-grade scale. For the 2022-2023 school year, Xavier continues to practice assigning grades to coursework. Xavier does not rank students.

## Test Results for Class of 2022

Since many colleges and universities adopted a test-optional or test-blind policy for the 2021-2022 admission cycle. Given the varied background of our students, the dangers and unknowns of COVID-19 and its transmission, and the frustration and inequity around registering and sitting for tests, Xavier has counseled its students to use their best judgment about taking standardized tests this year. Since a significant percentage of our seniors will not have test scores to report, we have decided to eliminate test score ranges from this Profile because they provide at best an incomplete context for evaluating our students.

## GPA Calculation

Only Courses taken at Xavier factor into the GPA Calculation. Non-Xavier courses taken for remedial purposes will appear on the Xavier transcript but will not factor into GPA calculation. The current highest GPA for six semesters at Xavier is 4.288 for the Class of 2023.

## Academic Information

A total of 27 credits is necessary for graduation. A student is required to take seven courses per year.

## Concurrent/Dual Enrollment

Students are not allowed to take a course at another institution if the course is offered at Xavier. Students wanting to enroll in a concurrent or dual enrollment course must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher; enrollment requires administrative approval. Dual enrollment for both high school and college credit is offered only via Creighton University.

## Solidarity and Outreach

Xavier's Solidarity and Outreach programs develop our students to graduate as men and women with and for others. Xavier strives to educate students with a focus on social justice while inviting them into relationship with the marginalized in our communities. In an effort to foster a spirit of intrinsically motivated service, Xavier has chosen not to quantify the number of hours a student "must" serve each year. Rather, students are "free to serve" in solidarity with our neighboring communities.

## Visual and Performing Arts

Xavier students' work is represented in a number of competitions, exhibitions, and shows. Currently our students' accomplishments are part of the Scholastic's Art and Writing Awards—both in the Regional and National venues: the Palm Springs Art Museum Creativity and Scholarship and Awards Program, the National Jesuit 4x5 Art Exhibit, Vans Custom Culture Competition, and the Congressional Art Competition.
